Asteroid Program After Middle = Success 2017-2018 School Year

- **Purpose**: To provide an after-school educationally-centered, supervised activity time, including homework, Arts and Crafts, Sports and Games, Technology and a nutritious snack in a safe, enriching and nurturing environment.
- **Philosophy**: Auburn Asteroids is a program of the Auburn Public Schools which extends the children's academic day through physical activity, supervised homework time, and an opportunity to play, work on crafts or on school projects. Asteroids will be housed at the Auburn Middle School.
- Health: Asteroids will follow the health and safety policies and procedures of the Auburn Public Schools.
- **Nutrition:** The program will provide one healthy snack during each session.
- **Transportation Plan**: Parents/Guardians are responsible for pick up at the end of the program and must sign their children out before they are dismissed.
- **Behavior Expectations**: Asteroids will follow the policies and procedures of the Auburn Public Schools.

• **Organizational Structure**: Program Directors (ratio 1:10)

- **School Calendar:** Auburn Asteroids will be open on those days when school is in session.
- Absence: If your child is absent from school, you must report his/her absence to the Asteroids' staff so that they do not expect him/her to attend that day. <u>You</u> must notify the school of absences.

NO SCHOOL – NO ASTEROIDS *******INCLEMENT WEATHER PROCEDURE******



Asteroids will not be open during snow days.

When school has been dismissed and weather is especially severe, Asteroids' staff will contact parents/guardians to ask them to pick up their children as early as possible. We will attempt to remain open until **3:30 p.m.** on severe weather days.

Late Pick Up Policy:

Pick up for the Asteroids Program is <u>no later than 5:30 p.m.</u>
We have established these FIRM procedures regarding late pick-up.

- 1. Parents will be assessed a fee of \$1.00 per minute for each minute late.
- If the late pick-up happens more than three times in one year, a conference will be convened between the Principal and the parents/guardians to determine whether the family is still eligible for the program.

In the event that a child remains in the program after the 5:30 p.m. pick up time, the following procedures will be followed.

- 1. An Asteroids' staff member will try to contact the parent/guardian for instructions.
- An Asteroid staff member will call the emergency contact list to arrange pickup. Parents will be charged a late fee for the amount of time the emergency contact is late.
- 3. If by 6:15 p.m. no contact has been made to either parents/guardians or emergency contact, a call will be placed to the Department of Children and Family (DCF) Emergency Unit to report an abandoned child. Staff members will then follow instructions of DCF staff as to where to bring the child.

Mandated Reporters:

Please be advised that all Asteroids Staff are mandated reporters under state law. Therefore, any unexplained cuts, abrasions, or other signs of abuse and neglect must be reported to the Department of Children and Family. Failure on anyone's part to do so can result in very strict penalties to the staff who worked with your child.
