



BI-COUNTY COLLABORATIVE STUDENT SCIENCE SAFETY AGREEMENT

I WILL:

1. Behave in a manner so that everyone will stay healthy, safe, and will be able to learn.
2. Closely follow all instructions given by the teacher.
3. Ask questions, state concerns, and ask for help before beginning a science activity.
4. Use protective devices for my eyes, face, hands, body and clothing during science activities as directed by the teacher.
5. Keep my work area clear and free of clutter during class.
6. Only use material and equipment that the teacher has organized for the class.
7. Never touch, smell or taste anything unless directed by the teacher
8. Keep my clothes, hair and jewelry away from science materials as directed by the teacher.
9. Wash my hands thoroughly as directed by the teacher
10. Report an accident to the teacher immediately.

I understand and realize that many accidents are caused by carelessness and being in a hurry. I will come to class prepared to be responsible so that everyone will be safe and able to learn.

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Parent and Student Responsibilities

The parents and students acknowledge that lack of participation in the assigned science labs will reduce the student's grade as determined by the teacher.
